- Prepare business investment proposals and budget analysis to support informed decision-making by the Board of Directors.

The role involves regular travel to the Pilbara to collaborate with Members, Beneficiaries and other stakeholders.

Our ideal candidate will have:

- Proven experience within social impact investment, business development or a similar role;
- Significant expertise in building capability, identifying and providing strategic introductions, and market analysis;
- A demonstrated commitment or ability to positively engage with Aboriginal people;
- Keen business acumen; and
- Strong finance background.
