Not only will you receive important job related training, cadets based in the metropolitan area will also attend formal class based training provided in partnership with North Metropolitan TAFE. You will be supported throughout your learning journey and will have access to mentors to assist you in reaching your career goals.

Regional placements at major centres will be considered on a case by case basis, however, the majority of the placements will be in the Perth metropolitan area.
