### POSITION SUMMARY:

The Yinhawangka Strategic Plan highlights the communities desire to connect people to traditional lore, protect country and heritage, and provide employment pathways.

Yinhawangka ranger work will involve on-country activities such as weed and feral animal control (spraying, trapping and removal), firefighting, fencing, data capture using the latest technology and other field activities as required.

The Corporation will fund North Regional TAFE studies in Certificate II, III and IV Conservation Land Management, with rangers provided tutoring support in Paraburdoo.

Yinhawangka rangers will have a strong focus on looking after country and culture.

### REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants to become Yinhawangka Rangers should consider these requirements below before registering their interest:

1. Yinhawangka men and women only.
2. Ability to travel and work on-country and protect cultural sites.
3. Willingness to engage with the public and represent the Yinhawangka community.
4. Available to spend time on-country, working away from home.
5. Interest to learn from Yinhawangka elders and TAFE to develop ranger skills.
