### To participate online, you'll need:


- · A smart phone, tablet or computer




To enter the meeting, you will need to read and accept the Terms and Conditions.




To register your attendance, enter your username and year of birth (YYYY).

> Your username is provided by Gumala and is 1 letter followed by 4 digits i.e. **B1234.** The first letter represents your language group, B for Banjima, Y for Yinhawangka, N for Nyiyaparli; and the remaining 4 digits are unique to each member.



On a desktop/laptop device the webcast will appear at the side automatically. On a mobile device, select the broadcast icon at the bottom of the screen to watch the webcast.



Once logged in, you will see the home page, which displays the meeting title and instructions.



During the meeting, mobile users can minimise the webcast at any time by selecting the arrow by the broadcast icon. You will still be able to hear the meeting. Selecting the broadcast icon again will reopen the webcast.




Pesktop/laptop users can watch the webcast full screen, by selecting the full screen icon .

To reduce the webcast to its original size, select the X at the top of the broadcast window.



To ask a written question, tap on the messaging icon ■, type your question in the chat box at the top of the screen and select the send icon ►.

Confirmation that your message has been received will appear.



When the Chair declares the poll open:

- A voting icon will appear on screen and the meeting resolutions will be displayed
- To vote, select one of the voting options.
   Your response will be highlighted
- To change your vote, simply select a different option to override

There is no need to press a submit or send button. Your vote is automatically counted. Votes may be changed up to the time the Chair closes the poll.



Questions sent via the Lumi platform may be moderated before being sent to the Chair. This is to avoid repetition and remove any inappropriate language.

A copy of your sent questions, along with any written responses from the meeting team, can be viewed by selecting "my messages".



## Icon descriptions



Home tab - Displays meeting instructions



Messaging tab - Submit written questions or comments



Voting tab - View and select voting options. Only visible once the chair opens voting
